**Divisions**: Madison (10% max weight variance) bracketing will be used – Rookie and Experienced

groups for each division (may combine experience groups and/or exceed 10% weight variance to get wrestlers matches). Will try to group wrestlers into 8/bracket with 2 pools of 4 wrestling round robins and then cross wrestle the pools for place finishes: A1

vs B2, B1 vs A2 winners wrestle for 1<sup>st</sup>, losers wrestle for 3<sup>rd</sup>. A3 vs B4, B3 vs A4, winners wrestle for 5<sup>th</sup>, losers wrestle for 7<sup>th</sup>. **ONLY TOP 4 RECEIVE AWARDS**

Division 2: 8/U – Born 2012-2013 Division 3: 10/U – Born 2010-2011 Division 4: 12/U – Born 2008-2009 Division 5: 14/U – Born 2006-2007

## **Tonawanda Youth Tournament Rules:**

- ✓ Period lengths Divisions 1,2,3 (1-1-1), Divisions 4,5 (1:00-1:30-1:30)
- ✓ NYS HS rules will be used with modified overtime rule: 1 minute neutral followed by 30 ride out. Choice goes to 1<sup>st</sup> point scored. If 0-0 then coin toss
- ✓ NYS High School Certified Officials HS rules apply for coach/official interactions
- ✓ USA Wrestling sanctioned event headgear is required!
- ✓ Zero Tolerance for Tobacco use this includes e-cigs

**Concessions**: Food and Drinks will be available

Wrist bands for coaches – No more than 2 coaches allowed in a corner during match – will accept USA, NYWAY/NUWAY or NYS High School coaching credentials – must have proof of coaching credentials on hand to receive wristband. Wristbands will be available at general admissions.
